Could you help make a difference to a young person's life in Salford?

Now is a very exciting time to join Salford Fostering Service. We want young people to grow up in happy, stable homes in which they can flourish, ideally within the Salford area, however this is not essential, but you must have the ability to transport children to and from school, family time, training, and attend meetings. You will have good parenting experience (this does not have to be with children of your own). Be over 21 and ideally have a spare bedroom (however we may look at those who are able to care for 0-2 years who may not have this). Salford are actively recruiting general foster carers to care for a diverse range of children and young people aged 0 – 18 who are in short term and long-term fostering placements. We need carers who can show compassion, commitment and understanding to children and young people during difficult times.

We offer a highly supportive and nurturing environment which enables individuals to grow. With excellent training packages, support groups, fostering buddies, on call service, as well as 24hr urgent support, allocated supervising social worker, support workers, monthly newsletters, events such as panto, celebration events, development days, Christmas party, support groups for foster carers own children as well as competitive allowances of up to £500 (tax free) per week per child as recently reviewed and uplifted (without affecting most benefits already received).
