Martyr - a person who is killed because of their beliefs.

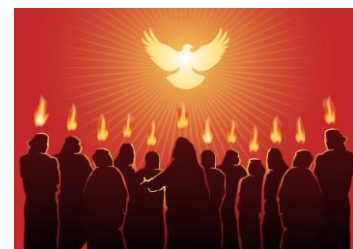
Mission - a vocation or calling to go out into the world and spread your faith.

- How did the events of Pentecost create witnesses of us all?*
- How does the Holy Spirit help us to be witnesses?*
- Who in our community is witness to caring for others?*
