## Reconciliation - Healing

### Key Vocabulary:

Anointing - to rub with oil as part of a religious ceremony or sacrament.

Compassion - being sympathetic and concerned for the misfortunes and sufferings of others.

Forgiveness - stopping the feeling of anger towards others who have wronged you.

Hospice - a home providing care for the terminally ill or sick.

Sacrament - an important ceremony in the Church which helps us to be closer to God's grace.

Responsibility - being accountable for something or having the duty to deal with an event.

In RE we will explore how in Jesus Christ, the world has been reconciled to God. Through and in Christ, every human being is offered the power to reach out in forgiveness and peace, to receive and to offer reconciliation. We will learn how, through the sacrament of the anointing of the sick, people are offered reconciliation even in their final moments, or when they are too ill to ask for themselves.

We will investigate these key questions:

- How can you show compassion for those who are ill?
- What did Jesus mean when he said "Your faith has made you well"?
- Is it our responsibility as Christians to care for others?
- How can prayer help the sick?
- How do we comfort and give hope to the sick?
- How do the sacraments bring healing to people who are very ill?
- Why do people visit Lourdes?
