
97% of parents state their chid is happy. This has improved each year in the last 2 years.





83% agree behaviour is positive. Our behaviour principles of being ready, respectful and safe are becoming embedded. Most pupils are engaging in restorative practice.



5. This school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the school year. (0 point)










87% agree. We track pupils' progress termly and provide interventions and boosters to help children achieve their potential. It is important that pupils invited to attend boosters do so.

11. The school lets me know how well my child is doing. (0 point)






85% agree. We have two Parent's Evenings and produce an end-of-year report so that parents are updated termly.


